Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show Contract Addendum

In consideration for the cooperation of the City of Chickasha and the Chickasha Municipal Airport Authority (hereinafter collectively "City") in allowing Mile High Air Boss, LLC (MHAB) to participate in the Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show on June 5 - 6, 2026 _____;

____MHAB_____ shall indemnify, save, and hold harmless the City from and against all loss, damages, liability, expenses (including attorney's fees), and costs arising from any activity, condition or event;

____MHAB_____ agrees to indemnify, save and hold harmless the City from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, losses, judgments, costs, expenses, including attorney fees, damages injuries or losses which may be brought by an agent, servant or employee of performer or any third party for any reason against the City or any of the City's agents, servants or employees, including but not limited to damages to real property, personal property, or for personal injury arising out of or as a result of performer's participation in the Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show;

____MHAB_____ hereby releases, quits and discharges the City from each, every, any and all right, claim, debt, demand, action, cause of action, suit, and proceeding of every kind at law or at equity, whether known or unknown, and releases and discharges the City from each, every, any and all injuries, damages, and losses whatsoever nature or character which may hereinafter be sustained as a result of attendance and/or participation at the Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show.

EXCEPTION: Death, injury, loss or damages to persons or property resulting solely from the willful misconduct and/or negligence of the City or any of the City's agents, servants or employees; and, in addition, any liability from another contract concerning the attendance and/or participation at the Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show, shall not be affected by this Defense, Indemnification, Hold Harmless Agreement.

Additional requirements:

- The City, if providing hotel accommodations, is not responsible for damage or incidental charges and _____MHAB_____ must provide a card on file to the hotel for any such charges.
- The City will be listed as named insured on _____MHAB's policy covering participation in Chickasha Wings & Wheels Airshow & Car Show.

If terms conflict between a contract and this addendum, the addendum supersedes the contract. Any contract and this addendum are governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma and any litigation should occur in the District Court of Grady County, Oklahoma.

The following proposal is presented to the City of Chickasha, OK for consideration of services and fees provided for the 2026 air show with proposed dates of June 5 - 6, 2026. This proposal does not constitute a contract unless terms are agreed to and signed by all parties.

Event Organizer shall provide:

1. **An elevated and secured control point/area that provides viewing of the entire aerial demonstration and Hot Ramp area.**
2. Unrestricted access, escorted if necessary, to all public and non-public areas of the event, including the aerobatic area, as needed, to make sure all necessary safety requirements have been satisfied.
3. One (1) double occupancy hotel room (or equivalent) with king sized bed and in room desk from one night prior to the first practice through the last night of the final performance.
4. Free or compensated high speed internet access in the room and at the show site.
5. One (1) full-sized vehicle for the exclusive use of Mile High Air Boss during the entire stay (including fuel and insurance.)
6. One golf cart (or equivalent) for the exclusive use of Mile High Air Boss during the entire stay (including fuel and insurance.) This vehicle is for use on the airfield only.
6. Prompt notification and inclusion in all planning meetings involving discussions of the aerial demonstration and emergency/incident/safety response plans.
8. 2 VIP Admissions for MHAB to any/all banquets, parties or other similar events held for air show performers or another event VIP's.
9. An access-controlled restroom facility (Port-A-Let, etc.) within a reasonable distance (less than 50 feet) from the control point.
10. A cooler with ice and drinking water easily accessible from the air show control point.
11. Food delivered to the control point area at lunch time each day of the show.

Mile High Air Boss Shall (MHAB) Provide;

Principle Responsibilities: The Event Organizer and Mile High Air Boss have a shared responsibility for all aspects of the aerial demonstration. The Event Organizer shall ensure a safe environment for the patrons and staff while MHAB shall assure the safety of the performers and their crew. Accordingly, MHAB will make every attempt to carry out the demonstration in a safe and timely manner in accordance with the operations plan. MHAB will consult with the Event Organizer in all areas where the safety of the performers is concerned. However, MHAB shall have the final and sole authority as to the safe conduct and operation of the aerial demonstration limited only by the authority of the IIC (Inspector-in-Charge) who is overseeing the aerial demonstration on behalf of the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration.)

In addition, MHAB shall provide the following services:

1. The Daily Safety Briefing
2. Assistance to the Event Organizer with the completion of the 7711-2
3. Assistance the Event Organizer with the development of the required Emergency Response, Incident Response and Safety Response Plans.
4. Assistance to the Event Organizer with the development of the Aerobatic Area.
5. Interface with the appropriate FAA Agencies, FSDO and IIC.
6. Interface with the overlying airspace controlling agency.
7. Interface with local ATC facility.
8. Assistance in obtaining any required Temporary Flight Restrictions. (TFR)
9. Interface with local airport operations personnel to the extent required for the aerial demonstration.
10. Interface with civilian performers regarding all aspects of the aerial demonstration.
 - i. ***MHAB will not manage any other contractual obligation between civilian performers and the Event Organizer.***
11. Interface with military performers regarding all aspects of the aerial demonstration as outlined in the appropriate team support manual.
 - i. ***MHAB will not manage any other contractual obligation between military performers and the Event Organizer.***

For the services described above and in addition to any costs incurred with the event organizers obligations described above, Mile High Air Boss will receive a fee of **\$4,500** made **payable by Check or Electronic Funds Transfer not later than the final safety briefing to R. Scott McMillan.** This fee will cover all pre-show activities described, plus 1 practice show and 1 full performance day. Additional onsite events requiring air boss services will be charged at \$1000/day. (i.e. arrival show, media show, night show, etc)

Disclaimer: R. Scott McMillan (Mile High Air Boss) is a highly experienced Airline Transport Pilot and Air Show Air Boss/Organizer. Although he has a vast knowledge of aviation rules and regulations he is not a certified Air Traffic Controller. His services are therefore provided with this understanding. In addition, Mile High Air Boss is not allowed, by FAA rule, to offer instruction to non-participating aircraft nor provided commercial traffic separation unless the local controlling ATC agency agrees in writing to such activities and such agreement is deemed satisfactory to MHAB and the FAA.

Air Show Performance Agreement

This Agreement is made and entered into this 20 day of JAN, by and between Chicklasha Municipal Airport Authority, hereafter called **PRODUCER** and **SRC AIRSHOWS**, hereinafter called **PERFORMER**.

1. **EVENT.** The PRODUCER will put on an air show at KCHK airport, in the city of CHickasha, State of OK, from June 6th to June 6th, hereinafter referred to as **_Wings and WHeels Airshow and Car show_**.

2. **PERFORMER OBLIGATIONS.** PERFORMER shall:

a. Perform aerobatic/Jet Car/Plane race performances of approximately 10 minutes in duration each.

b. AIRPLANE SOLO ACT PER DAY 1 (1 per day)

c. _____

d. AIRPLANE SOLO ACT PER NIGHT 0 \$1000.00 EXTRA PER NIGHT ACT

e. Arrive, weather permitting, on the day before the AIR SHOW or on the day of the first Press appearances. Depart, weather permitting, on the day following the PERFORMER'S last aerobatic performance. f. Provide liability Insurance in the amount of one million dollars, U.S.funds. (Proof of insurance will be provided upon request.)

g. Provide pre-event promotional materials including photos, brochures, and biography, to the PRODUCER and be available for Press appearances on the day of the AIR SHOW. Pictures and Videos can be found on WWW.SRCAIRSHOWS.COM

3. **PRODUCER OBLIGATIONS.** PRODUCER shall:

a. Provide aircraft/jetcar services as follows:

(1) All on-site fuel

A. (100 octane avgas) for practice flights/teaser, media and promotion flights/teaser, performances and departure fuel. **Airplane** will use 12 Gals of 100L per performance. Fuel to and from airport and while at airport for performance/ Fuel to and from show will be reimbursed to Src Airshows. 50 Gals of fuel at \$ 6.00 per gal 100LL TOTAL \$300.00

B. Jet Car fuel ON ROAD DIESEL ONLY. 0.00 GALS of fuel will be needed for show also to and from show compensation. If Producer wants to have more performances, then on this contract it is 100Gals per Performance.

(2) Engine Oil 12 qts aeroshell 100W PLUS

(3) Smoke Oil 8 gallons per performance. Paraffin-based (Paraffnic) oil is the only acceptable smoke oil.

(4) Provide 1 hours of cool down and preparations time in-between acts.

(5) Hangar Covered, indoor, and secure hangar space from time of arrival until time of departure for the Airplane

(6) Airplane cost. Operating cost of the **Airplane** is \$225.00 per hour. This is the cost of flight time to and from show. WAIVED

(7) Performance fee/ACT \$7500

(8) Lodging

A. Provide lodging consisting of 1, private, non-smoking, king size or double rooms at or in close proximity to the AIR SHOW site.

b. Provide 1 full size air-conditioned vehicle(s) for transportation of the PERFORMER and the PERFORMER'S support crew/staff. PRODUCER shall provide and pay for insurance on all rental cars as required by the rental car agency and all fuel.

4. **PERFORMER'S INABILITY TO PERFORM.**

Should the PERFORMER be unable to perform for reasons under his control, including reasons of health or equipment deficiencies, PERFORMER shall refund to the PRODUCER all monies expended by the

PRODUCER to the PERFORMER including any down payment and travel costs.

Should the PERFORMER be unable to perform after arrival at the AIR SHOW site for reasons not under his control, including weather, full payment of the PERFORMANCE FEE and all travel costs shall be paid to the PERFORMER. PERFORMER in his sole discretion shall determine whether conditions allow the conduct of any flight/race by PERFORMER.

5. AIR SHOW NON-PERFORMANCE.

Should the AIR SHOW be cancelled for reasons not within the control of the PERFORMER, the following amounts shall be payable:

- a. If the PRODUCER provides written notice of cancellation at least 45 days before the first show date, PERFORMER shall only be paid the down payment. Deposits are Non-refundable BUT If a Deposit was Paid by the PRODUCER the deposit will be held over/credited for the next airshow that the PRODUCER will be doing.
- b. If the PRODUCER provides written notice of cancellation less than 45 days prior to the show date but not less than 2 days prior to the show date, PERFORMER shall be paid the down payment and 50% of the PERFORMANCE FEE plus any travel costs actually incurred.
- c. If the PRODUCER provides notice later than indicated in 5.b above, the down payment and total PERFORMANCE FEE, including travel costs shall be paid.

6. FORCE MAJEURE. If, on account of causes not due to the fault or negligence of either party, such as, but not limited to, national emergency, disaster, or an act of God, the AIR SHOW is abandoned, cancelled, or prevented, neither party hereto shall be liable to the other for any expense incurred in connection with the AIR SHOW except that PRODUCER shall pay PERFORMER for any travel costs actually incurred prior to receipt of notice that the AIR SHOW is abandoned. Deposits are Non-refundable BUT If a Deposit was Paid by the PRODUCER the deposit will be held over/credited for the next airshow that the PRODUCER will be doing.

7. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR. The PRODUCER and the PERFORMER shall be and act as independent parties, and under no circumstances shall this Agreement be construed as one of agency, partnership or joint venture of employment between either. The PRODUCER shall be solely responsible for the conduct of its employees, personnel, and agents in connection with their performance of the PRODUCER'S obligations hereunder.

8. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The terms set forth in this instrument supersede all prior oral or written understandings and constitute the entire agreement between PRODUCER and PERFORMER. It may be amended or altered only by a subsequent writing signed by both parties.



EVENT. The Producer will put on an airshow at Chickasha OK, KCHK, on June 5 & 6, 2026, hereafter referred to as AIRSHOW.

1. PERFORMER OBLIGATIONS. PERFORMER shall:
 - a. Perform 1 aerobatic performance of approximately 8 minutes in duration per AIRSHOW day unless otherwise arranged.
 - b. Arrive, weather permitting, on June 4th, and depart following the last airshow performance or on the first practical day after the last performance.

 - a. Provide Aircraft services as follows:

 - b. Provide Lodging consisting of 1 clean non-smoking room in close proximity to AIRSHOW site beginning upon arrival and available as long after the show as needed should the PERFORMER become "weathered in" at that AIRSHOW location.
 - c. Provide a rental car for the PERFORMER to travel to and from the hotel/airport. This will be extended as needed, should PERFORMER become "weathered in". Producer shall provide and pay for insurance on the rental car, if provided, as required by the rental car agency.
 - d. Ensure members of CRASH, FIRE and RESCUE will be present during performances, attend airshow briefings and participate in 1.1 briefings at aircraft. Ensure a "fast response" 4wd CFR vehicle will be placed near the "hot" side of the crowd line and will be manned continuously during the aerobatic performances. Fast Response vehicle will contain fire extinguishers, leather gloves and a fire ax at a minimum.

- e. PAY PERFORMER a performance fee in the total of \$4500 for PERFORMER participation in the AIRSHOW. Down payment in the amount of 50% is due upon execution of this Agreement. The balance is due prior to the PERFORMER'S aerobatic airshow.

3. PERFORMER INABILITY TO PERFORM.

Should the PERFORMER be unable to perform for reasons under their control, including reasons for health or equipment deficiencies, PERFORMER shall refund to the PRODUCERS all monies paid to the PERFORMER including down payments and travel costs.

Air Show Performance Agreement for Erik Edgren Airshows

This Agreement is made and entered into this day of 12/12/2025 by and between Chickasha Municipal Airport Authority of Chickasha, OK, hereafter called PRODUCER and Erik J. Edgren hereinafter called PERFORMER.

1. **EVENT.** The PRODUCER will put on an airshow at **KCHK** airport, in the State of **Oklahoma**, on **06/06/2026** hereinafter referred to as AIRSHOW.
2. **PERFORMER'S OBLIGATIONS.** PERFORMER shall:
 - a. Perform **2** aerobatic performances per 12 hour airshow day/night.
 - b. Arrive, weather permitting, **06/04/26**. Depart, weather and or remaining daylight permitting, following the PERFORMER'S last aerobatic performance or on the first day practical after the last performance.
3. **PRODUCER'S OBLIGATIONS.** PRODUCER shall:
 - a. **Provide aircraft services as follows:**
 - (1) All on-site fuel (100 octane avgas) for practice flights, media and promotion flights, performances (approx. 2.5 gallons per flight) and up to 30 gallons of departure fuel.
 - (2) Engine Oil 1 case (12 quarts) Phillips 20W50 XC
 - (3) Smoke Oil 5 gallons per flight (Pure White "Smoke Oil" or equivalent) Paraffin-based (Paraffinic) oil is the only acceptable smoke oil.
 - (4) Hangar Covered and secure hangar space with closeable and lockable door and cement or similar floor, from time of arrival until time of departure for airshow aircraft.
 - (5) Security General public will not be allowed to touch, prod, poke, hang off, sit on, ram into or otherwise damage my airplane, **because those things can KILL me.**
 - b. Lodging consisting of 1, private, non-smoking, room with king size bed, on the highest floor and quietest side, at or in close proximity to the AIRSHOW site beginning upon arrival and available as long after the show as needed should PERFORMER become "weathered in" at AIRSHOW. Lodging must be clean and quiet. Should the room provided be unacceptable PERFORMER will bill PRODUCER for any lodging expenses incurred. Note: If you would stay in the room, knowing **your life depended on a good night's sleep** it will be ok.

- c. Automobile for the PERFORMER's exclusive use consisting of 1 full sized air-conditioned vehicle, from the time of PERFORMER's arrival to departure. PRODUCER shall provide and pay for insurance for the automobile.
 - d. If a "Comedy" act is contracted, PRODUCER must provide a volunteer to pretend to be the pilot for the set up to the comedy act. That person must be 18 years or older, have narrow hips, be physically flexible, and able to follow directions and available on practice day for training. Please ask for more details over the phone.
 - e. If a "Comedy" act is contracted, PERFORMER must be able to perform an aerial site survey of the airshow box. This is both a safety issue to determine what might be lurking in the box to kill me, and a quality of act issue so I can provide the show with the most entertaining act.
 - f. CRASH, FIRE, RESCUE: A member of CFR who will be present during performances will attend airshow briefings and a one-on-one briefing at aircraft with PERFORMER or PERFORMER'S designee. Further, in addition to other CFR assets, a "Fast Response" 4wd CFR vehicle will be placed at show center, on the "hot" side of the crowd line, and will be manned continuously during the aerobatic performances. Fast Response vehicle will contain fire extinguishers, leather gloves and fire axe at minimum.
 - g. All necessary credentials, body and vehicle for all PERFORMER personnel, to allow full 24 hour access of aircraft, facilities and show site, **with automobile** on arrival to the AIRSHOW until PERFORMER departs airshow. PERFORMER must be able to park automobile next to or very near aircraft on show days. This is necessary both as safety of flight issue (climate controlled quiet place for performer) and to facilitate multiple flights per day (access to tools, etc.)
 - h. All necessary permits, forms and/or approvals from Federal, State and/or Local entities.
 - i. Compensation; A down payment, ***in the amount of Actual 30%*** is due upon the execution of this Contract. The Balance of the fee, will be paid in full, prior to the final performance of the AIRSHOW.
4. a. In consideration for the above flight(s), THE EVENT agrees to compensate the PERFORMER as follows: ***TOTAL FEE: \$8447.00.***
5. **PERFORMER INABILITY TO PERFORM.** Should the PERFORMER have to cancel prior to departure for the PERFORMER will return the Deposit. However, once the PERFORMER has departed for the airshow no refund of the deposit will be made. Should the PERFORMER be unable to perform after arrival at the airshow site due to mechanical or personal health reasons the remainder of the fee will be paid on a pro-rata basis by number of performances flown. Should the PERFORMER be unable to perform after arrival at the airshow site for reasons not under their control, including weather, full payment of the PERFORMANCE FEE will be made by the PRODUCER. PERFORMER, in their sole discretion shall determine whether conditions allow the conduct of any flight.

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6. **PRODUCER NON-PERFORMANCE** A) Weather Cancellation: Total Fee Amount is due if the performer is prepared to fly a scheduled flight and is precluded to do so by meteorological conditions. The PERFORMER has final say on Go/ No Go decisions. B.) In the event of non-performance due to issues under the control of the PRODUCER (failure to obtain proper clearances, permits, improper fuel, incorrect smoke oil, etc.) the Total Fee Amount shall be due to the PERFORMER. C.) However, only 50% of the total fee amount shall be due to the PERFORMER if the official written notice of cancellation and check for said 50% is received by the PERFORMER **prior** to 60 days of the first contracted performance date. If official written notice of cancellation is received **within** 60 days of the first contracted performance 100% of the Total Fee Amount shall be due to the PERFORMER. NOTE: Any indemnification beyond what is provided below must be presented at contract signing. Should the PRODUCER or any other entity require an alternate indemnification agreement for the PERFORMER to participate in the Air Show, and the PERFORMER does not agree to that indemnification agreement, the PRODUCER will have cancelled and will be subject to the cancellation schedule in this paragraph.

7. **INDEMNIFICATION** PERFORMER, both jointly and severally, for ourselves, our heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, do hereby knowingly, willingly and voluntarily assume all risks of accident or damage to ourselves or to our employees and personnel, or to our property, with the exception of accidents or damage caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Air Show.

Subject to the Performer's aircraft insurance coverage, Performer agrees to assume all responsibility, hold harmless, indemnify and defend The Air Show and their officers, agents and employees from third party claims, loss, cost or expense for any injury or damage caused by us to other person(s) or other property arising directly out of our participation in said Air Show with the exception of accidents or damage caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Air Show, This general release and indemnification covers the period of the PERFORMER'S attendance at the Air Show.

The Indemnified Parties shall promptly notify Performer in writing of any claim or action subject to indemnification hereunder.
